

Write a technical paper on “**History of Polymer Matrix Composites for Civil Engineering Applications with a Particular Reference to Structural Engineering**”.

Length of the paper should be no more than **5 sheets** including a cover page. The format of the manuscript must be as per the specified guidelines.

Note: The meaning of history is “a continuous, systematic narrative of past events as relating to a particular people, country, period, person, etc., usually written as a chronological account”. Please describe series of past events and advances related to the topic in a chronological sequence with time periods attached to each development.

Guidelines for Preparation of Papers

SUBMISSION

Entire manuscript should be prepared by the authors using MS Word in portrait form as per instructions given below to ensure uniformity in appearance of the papers.

LAYOUT

JUSTIFY the text throughout.

LENGTH

Each manuscript of the paper is to be **LIMITED STRICTLY TO 5 PAGES including** photos, figures, tables, appendices, annexes, etc., which should **ALL** be placed together at the end after the references section of the text. Only the first 5 sheets will be assessed if the length of the paper exceeds 5 pages. This limit includes cover page.

MANUSCRIPT

Type on **letter size** paper only. The **print area** should be such that the margins on all sides are 1 inch each. All the text and artwork (including Figure captions) should fall within this area. Do not leave any unnecessary space.

TYPING

- The entire text should be typed using **TIMES NEW ROMAN** and justified.

Title

Type the exact title of paper in Title Case with **14-Point Bold** typeface and “Center” it.

Author's Name

Type the authors name (in order of first, middle and last name) with **12 point Bold** typeface. Do not use titles (Prof. Ph.D., Mr., Miss etc.). Names of author(s) should be “centered”.

If the authors wish to give designations, they can do so by using **10 point normal italics** typeface.

Affiliation of author(s) including organization, city, country and e-mail addresses should be given below the names of authors. Please use **10 point italics** typeface for the affiliation(s). The affiliation(s) should be “centered” as per the sample enclosed.

ABSTRACT

The abstract should be no longer than 150 words. Do not include references or equations in the abstract. Use **10 point italics** typeface. The abstract should be “centered” with **12 point bold** title case.

HEADING

1st Level Heading of sections of the text should be in 11-point **BOLD UPPER CASE** and have one line space (11pt) above and below it.

2nd Level Heading should be in 11-point **Bold Title Case** and should have one line (11pt) of space with text above but no space with text below.

3rd Level Heading should be in 11-point ***Bold Italics Title Case*** and should have one line of space (11pt) with text above but no space with text below.

MAIN TEXT

The main text will be in **11-point** (Times New Roman).

TABLES AND FIGURES

All the tables and figures referred in the text of the paper should be placed at the end of the text. Figures will follow the tables. Tables and figures should be numbered separately. Place table title above the table and figure caption below the figure. Allow **one line space** between the table and its title and between the figure and its caption.

If Table/Figure does not fit into the width of the print area, one may use the "landscape form" for this section alone. Use the "Section Break" option. Allow one line of space between the table or figure and the adjacent text. Figures and tables not referred in the text should not be included.

EQUATIONS

All equations must be set or clearly typed and consecutively numbered. Displayed equations should be numbered simply as (1), (2), (3). The numbers should appear at the extreme right of the line in parentheses. Refer to the equations in the subsequent text as Eq. (1), Eq. (2) etc., All equations should have one line space between the equation and text material. Whenever more than one equation is required to be stated consecutively in text, they may be separated by two blank line spaces.

REFERENCES

References are to be listed at the end of the paper in the order cited in the text and referred in the text by the last name of the first author and the year of publication like in Smith (1975). Abbreviate journal titles according to standard norms. Only those references cited in the text should be listed at the end in the list of references.

PAGE NUMBERING

Please number the pages sequentially. Only first 5 pages will be assessed (including cover page, if any).
