**3. Basic Requirement**

- PDF format
- Cover Page includes
  - o Project title
  - o Group number
  - o Group name if available
  - o Group member official full name + student ID
- Font size 11, Double Space
- Bibliography list if there is any citation. Any consistent citation format is acceptable.
- Suggested length : 3000 words(+/-10%) including graphs, tables, excluding reference list and appendix.

**4. Submission**

The only acceptable form of submission is electronic via the submission link in the unit's Canvas site. Hardcopy and email submissions will NOT be accepted. Late submissions will be penalized.(late submission penalty : 1 point a day) It is imperative that your project report is submitted in ONE document. Only a PDF format document will be accepted, and it is your responsibility to ensure all pages correctly display your original content. Missing or distorted figures and formulas will result in lower marks.

## **5. Peer Evaluation**

Once your group has submitted the term paper, you can submit your peer evaluation. If you think all the other group members should share the same grade, you do not need to submit peer evaluation. However, if you think some of the group members barely make any contribution, you can write a short notes and email me. Your peer evaluation feedback will be confidential to the other group members.

By inadequate contribution, it refers to the irresponsible behavior (e.g. not responding to the emails, seldom show up for the meetings, do not work on the agreed assigned tasks). The inadequate contribution does not refer to different view points or subjective evaluation of other team member's ability. In the short note, please indicate your group number and title, your name and student ID, your group member's name and Student ID. You are also required to provide some evidence to justify your evaluation.

The deadline for the submission of peer evaluation feedback is Friday mid-night week 12. I will look into the case if some team member receives common complaint with justifiable evidence. The individual grade will be adjusted downwards based on group grade to reflect the personal poor attitude towards the group work.

## **7. Assessment Criteria**

1. Submit the term paper by the due date and confine to the basic requirements.
2. The presentation of the paper, formatting and grammar.
3. Well structured, coherent and complete
4. Appropriate use of graphs/figures and tables to illustrate the results.
5. Argument is logical and self-consistent.
6. Assumptions are clearly laid out and discussions are based on the reasonable assumptions.
7. Appropriate use of data from various resources in conducting estimation and analyzing in a quantitative way wherever applicable.
8. Correct use of methods and formulas as discussed in lectures.
9. Cite appropriate academia journal articles to support your assumptions or arguments wherever applicable
10. Set the goal of the paper in the introduction and summarize the paper and discuss some limitations of your work in the conclusion
